External Bilateral Trade

Greece - Turkey

- Turkey - → strategic trade partner for Greece
- Expansion of Greek exports' portfolio to Turkey - ► key strategic movement for Greece
- Bilateral trade between Greece & Turkey
 - Overall, decreased in 2009, because of the economic crisis
 - We believe that it will recover in the short-medium term
 - Greek exports to Turkey (2009): 605.9 euro
 - Main products: textiles&clothing, chemicals&plastics, machinery
 - Trade deficit for Greece (2009): \$\frac{1}{40}\$

Greece --- Turkey

- Large number of Greek investors in Turkey
- Greece is among the 5 top investing countries in Turkey
- 76 Greek companies are operating in Turkey today
- Main sectors: banking services, cement industry, pharmaceuticals, fishery, tourism, health services

Turkey - - - → Greece

- Significantly smaller number of Turkish investors in Greece
- But, there is potential for increase, through joint ventures etc



Establishing a sound base for strong cooperation among Greek and Turkish enterprises

- Turkey opportunities for Greek enterprises
 - High GDP growth
 - Strong & productive Industry
 - Large size of consumer market
 - Gateway to Central Asia and Former Soviet Union counties
 - Specifically for Northern Greece, because of geographical proximity
- Greece opportunities for Turkish enterprises
 - Geopolitical position of Greece
 - - ► link for Turkish goods to Balkans & EU-27
 - Important infrastructure convenience (Egnatia)
